

D17 – Audit, Quality Control or Inspection Multiple Entry Visa

The D17 Visa is designed for professionals responsible for audits, quality control, or inspections at company branches within Indonesia. Available in 1-year and 2-year validity options, it allows for a stay of up to 60 days per visit, with the added benefit of extension without leaving the country. This streamlined process enables individuals to efficiently carry out their duties while minimizing the disruption of international travel. By supporting these key functions, the D17 Visa ensures the smooth operation and compliance of international businesses operating in Indonesia.



Type of Visa D17 (1 Year)

A person who conducts audits, quality control, or inspections at company branches in Indonesia. You can apply for a multiple-entry visa valid for 1 year. Periods of stay for this visa will be granted for up to 60 days for each visit.

Type of Visa D17 (2 Years)

A person who conducts audits, quality control, or inspections at company branches in Indonesia. You can apply for a multiple-entry visa valid for 2 years. Periods of stay for this visa will be granted for up to 60 days for each visit.

Stay

- Up to 60 Days per entry

With this visa you can

- Carry out activities related to audits, quality control, or inspections at company branches.
- Conducting activities related to tourism, and visiting friends or family.

You must

- Comply with laws and regulations.
- Respect local customs, culture, and wisdom.
- Have sufficient living expenses while in Indonesia.

Other information

- Staying in Indonesia over the period of your stay permit, engaging in prohibited activities, not complying with visa conditions, and/or not complying with Indonesian laws may result in you paying fines, being deported, and/or other legal charges.
- You are prohibited from selling goods or services.
- You are prohibited from receiving rewards, wages, or any similar from individuals or corporations in Indonesia.

Document Requirement

- Passport valid for at least 6 (six) months (for holders of travel documents other than passports, such as emergency passports or identity documents, the validity must be at least 12 months). (JPG format)
- Personal bank statement showing a minimum balance of USD \$2,000 or equivalent for the last 3 months (including the account holder's name, statement period, and account balance). (PDF format)
- A recent color photograph. (JPG format)
- Curriculum Vitae (CV). (PDF format)
- Guarantee letter from the guarantor. (PDF format)
- Statement letter from a government agency or private institution as the host of the program that explains the foreigner's activities during in Indonesia. (PDF format)
- Travel itinerary. (PDF format)

Document Requirement for Visa Extension Application

- e-Visa and ITK (visit stay permit) (PDF Format)
- Original Passport (physical passport)
- Proof of guarantee from the guarantor. (PDF format)
- Return Airline Tickets (PDF Format)

Visa Validity

This visa must be used within 90 days from the date of issue.

Please note that the visa validity period is different from the period of stay, kindly check your visa for the period of stay Information.

A Multiple Entry Visa can be converted into a KITAS without the need to leave Indonesia, provided that all transfer requirements are met.

Note:

Stay duration is up to 60 days and can be extended twice, with each extension granting an additional 60 days. The visa must be used within 90 days from the date of issuance. It is important to note that the visa's validity period differs from the allowed period of stay, so kindly refer to your visa for specific details. A Multiple-Entry Visa can be converted into a KITAS without the need to leave Indonesia, provided all transfer requirements are met. Visa extensions should be initiated two weeks before the stay period for each visit under the Multiple-Entry Visa expires.
